Dear Community Members,

The Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC) is pleased to present the 2008-2009 Annual Report on the progress of PYLUSD building programs funded by Measure A and Measure Y dollars. The eight member CBOC continues to monitor the projects funded by the bond measures through regular meetings, site visits, and sessions with PYLUSD management and facilities staff.

The CBOC was formed by appointment by the PYLUSD in spring of 2008 to oversee the expenditures of Measure A that passed in the February 5, 2008 election. This \$200 million school bond is providing for modernization and improvements on the PYLUSD campuses. More information regarding specific projects is available on the PYLUSD website. The Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee also took over the responsibility of the remaining Measure Y funds after June 30, 2008.

The mission of the CBOC is to ensure that bond revenues are expended only for projects listed on the ballot measure as well as to ensure that no bond funds are used for any teacher or administrative salaries or other school operating expenses. Also, the CBOC is to report to the public, via an annual report, concerning the expenditure of bond revenues, the district's compliance with the requirements of school bond expenditures, and CBOC activities over the past year.

The District engaged Total School Solutions (TSS) to conduct the annual independent performance audit for facilities and report its findings to the CBOC. Based on the review of annual financial and performance audit reports and information received at Committee meetings, the CBOC certifies that the bond proceeds for the 2008-2009 fiscal year were expended only for the purposes set forth in the Measure Y and A ballot measures and that no bond proceeds were expended for teachers' or administrators' salaries or other school operating expenses.

The following pages of this year's CBOC Annual Report highlights some of the 2008-2009 district projects, CBOC activities, and an overview of bond expenditures.
